Other winners:

- Angela Astuccio of Foxborough, Mass., a biological sciences student attending Mount Holyoke College, earned the third prize of \$1,500 for her essay on nanotechnology.
- Two honorable mention prizes of \$750 were presented to Kevin Ma of Parkville, Mo., a biomedical engineering student attending Johns Hopkins University, and Leslie Mann of Nazareth, Pa., a chemistry student attending Drexel University.

Kelly's Future Scientists Program was established in 2000 to help connect entry-level science students with jobs, internships, and research opportunities at major chemical, pharmaceutical, and biotech companies in the United States. The program provides a bridge between the scientific expertise of students and professors in academia and the personnel and recruiting needs of the science industry.
