"It is gratifying to know I have made an impact on a student when they remember me from several years ago, having spent only a short amount of time with them in the classroom."

Each year, as part of a long-standing tradition and an integral component in demonstrating how KES values employees, field managers have the opportunity to nominate substitute teachers for a state-level Substitute Teacher of the Year award. Nominations are based on performance, feedback and recommendations from permanent teachers and school administrators at the schools where the substitute teachers have been assigned. Winners of the state-level Substitute Teacher of the Year award receive a \$100 bonus and are then eligible for the national Substitute Teacher of the Year award.
